






Target 3 of SDG 12 is to halve per capita global food waste at the retail and consumer levels and reduce food losses along production and supply chains losses by 2030.

Our Approach

TARGET

Commit to reduce food waste and set targets – clear timelines to redistribute food surplus in our own operations.

MEASURE

Publish food waste data – Tesco was the first UK retailer to publish data on UK food waste in our own operations and has helped to identify food waste hotspots

ACT

Collaborate across the supply chain - work with our farmers, growers and suppliers to reduce food waste where it occurs.




